Lastly, the theme will highlight how our beloved Prophet instilled morality and reason while motivating his followers to stay steadfast on Sirat al Mustaqim which helped his companions hold onto their strong Islamic identity as they established a well grounded moral and ethical community together. We can learn from the transformative and powerful influence our beloved Prophet had on his community that eventually changed the course of human history.



Furthermore, it will focus on how our beloved prophet used moral principles and ethical reasoning to motivate his followers to stay steadfast on Sirat al Mustaqim, which established the Muslim identity.




Can Muslims, by remaining firm on the Deen of Allah (swt) and the Sunnah of our beloved Prophet , intellectually challenge the existing norms of a morally shifting society where everything, including the Truth, is viewed as relative?

#### Surah Al-Hadid { 57:28 }

#### يَۦٓٛأَيَّهَا ٱلَّذِينَ ءَامَنُواْ ٱتَّقُواْ ٱللَّهَ وَءَامِنُواْ بِرَسُولِهِ يُؤْتِكُمْ كِفْلَيْنِ مِن رَّحْمَتِهِ وَيَجْعَل لَّكُمْ نُورًٖا تَمْشُونَ بِهِ وَيَغْفِرْ لَكُمْ ۖ وَٱللَّهُ غَفُورٌۭ رَّحِيمٌٖ ٢٨

O you who believe, fear Allāh and believe in His Messenger; He will [then] give you a double portion of His mercy and make for you a light by which you will walk and forgive you; and Allāh is Forgiving and Merciful. (Saheeh International: Q 57:28)

This will be motivational talk to persuade Muslims to hold onto their deen and the sunnah of Prophet because it appeals to the heart and human intellect. The focus of this talk will be on how Muslims can use moral reasoning to impart the Islamic narrative that is counter to the present cultural values that often seem self-destructive and likely to fail humanity. The idea is to persuade Muslims to gracefully challenge existing norms by following the sunnah of our Prophet and forming role model families that positively influence the culture we live in.



Dr. Haifaa Younis is an American Board Certified Obstetrician and Gynecologist with roots from Iraq. Her pursuit of Islamic knowledge began when she began to study with various Islamic scholars from across the United States while she simultaneously attended individual courses and lectures on subjects including Aqeeda, Fiqh, usual Fiqh, Hadeeth, and Tazkiyah (purification of the soul). From the United States, she moved to Saudi Arabia where she graduated from the Mecca Institute of Islamic Studies (Jeddah, Saudi Arabia) and Al-Huda Qur'an Memorization School (Jeddah, Saudi Arabia) where she completed the memorization of the Qur'an. She is the founder and Chairman of Jannah Institute and currently teaches seminars on the thematic commentary of various chapters of the Holy Qur'an and their practical relevance in our day-to-day living. Additionally, she offers retreats on key topics that inspire hearts,



Dr. Yasir Qadhi, PhD, is a resident Scholar of the Memphis Islamic Center, a professor at Rhodes College in the Department of Religious Studies, and is the Dean of Academic Affairs at AlMaghrib Institute. He graduated with a BSc in Chemical Engineering from the University of Houston, and studied at the Islamic University of Madinah where he completed a BA from the College of Hadith and Islamic Sciences followed by a MA in Islamic Theology from the College of Dawah. He then returned to the United States, and completed a PhD in Religious Studies from Yale University. He is one of the few people who has combined a traditional Eastern Islamic seminary education with a Western academic training of the study of Islam.


FREE snacks will be provided for the kids in the childcare.
